Don't forget! Utilize your IRA qualified charitable distribution. People age 70 1/2 or older can make a gift of up to \$100,000 by transferring IRA assets to the Community Foundation. If married, each spouse can transfer up to \$100,000 from their IRA. Please note, transfers to create or contribute to donor advised funds are not allowed.

You may also make gifts of appreciated stocks, bonds, and mutual funds that result in a charitable deduction for the full market value of the donated asset and help avoid capital gains tax.
